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VENDOR GUIDELINES All vendors participating in the PECAN FEST MARKET agree to the Vendor Guidelines set forth in this document.

Each vendor are required to have hand sanitizer at their booth.

If you are experiencing any symptoms of a communicable illness, please stay home.

Facility for the Event: The MARKET will take place in the Pecan Museum of the Texas Agricultural Education & Heritage Center.

Description of Main Items being sold: On the application, select one primary item or category of items to be sold. For example, this could be antiques, fiber, woodcrafts, food, etc. Vendors may sell other items along with their main item at the discretion of TAEHC. When the MARKET is full, a waiting list will be generated based on the main item to be sold.

Check in: Vendors must check in by 8:30 AM on the morning of the EVENT and be fully set up and your vehicle moved over to assigned area by 10:00 AM. If you want to make arrangements to set up on the Friday before the event, please call, text or email.

Vendor Set Up: Vendor agrees to provide his/her own tables, chairs, tent, canopy and any other necessary equipment. Vendor is responsible for their booth operation. Minimal electricity is available. Vendors agree to be set up promptly by 9:30 AM. Vendor spaces will be labeled. Please stay within in your space. On indoor vendors we will let you know if we have tables.

No grills are allowed or other equipment that could potentially burn or damage any of the facilities in the Center. Additionally, no items can be attached to the walls, doorways or floors of any facility.

Vendor will be responsible for any damage they inflict upon the premise, accidentally or otherwise.

Vendor tear down/clean up: Vendor agrees to remove all items at the end of the event. Reasonable time will be allotted for this. All trash, including empty boxes, packing materials, etc., must be removed from the property. The area must be left in the same condition in which it was found.

Sales Tax ID: If applicable, Vendor is responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax collected in Seguin, Guadalupe County. Vendor must display a Sales Tax ID number if required.

Insurance/Hold Harmless: Vendor indemnifies, releases, and holds harmless, the Texas Agricultural Education & Heritage Center, their agents and representatives from and against all claims, demands, causes of action for personal injury or property damage of any kind and character and all losses, liabilities, cost expenses (including attorney's fees), without limit or limitations, and without regard to the cause , or the negligence be sole, joint or concurrent, for any injury, illness or death of any person or damage to any property arising out of or in conjunction with the vendors participation in this show or the use of any of the facilities.

Food: Vendor may not prepare food for immediate consumption in the facility or on the grounds without prior approval.

Vendor Parking: Park in the area designated for VENDOR PARKING. This allows our customers to park close to the entrance of the grounds.
